Resthaven is respected for the delivery of high quality, responsive care services for older South Australians and currently operates residential aged care facilities at nine locations, offering accommodation to over 1,000 older people. A range of in home community care and support options are offered throughout metropolitan Adelaide, the Adelaide Hills, Murraylands and across the Limestone Coast, with more than 6,000 clients benefiting from these services.

Resthaven employs approximately 1,350 staff who are supported by 400 volunteers.
