### Walls Going Up at Resthaven Mount Gambier Site

By the end of next week, it is anticipated that 40% of the walls will be up at the Resthaven Mount Gambier Aged Care Facility building site.

The majority of the work will take place from 4–6 May.

Once the pre-cast wall panels are in place, the cranes will move in, and important structural work will commence.

Some delays in progress have pushed the completion date forward to April 2011. However, Resthaven CEO, Richard Hearn, is still optimistic about the project.

‘This work will significantly boost the local economy, provide much needed support and care for older people in the area, as well as create approximately 100 long term jobs,’ Richard says.

‘Resthaven has been providing community services throughout the Limestone Coast for several years, and the residential facility will complement these services.’
