Resthaven Aberfoyle Park is coming!

Conveniently located in the main shopping precinct of Aberfoyle Park, Resthaven Aberfoyle Park will offer high quality, attractive, purpose built aged care accommodation for 100 people from 2018.

The design incorporates a community “hub,” including a café, shop, barbeque areas, hairdressing salon, children’s play area, private dining/function rooms, a large communal meeting room, and an Internet Café. Professionally landscaped garden areas and courtyards are protected, secure, safe and accessible. The aim is to encourage engagement with the local community.

Residents will be accommodated in single rooms featuring private ensuite bathrooms and large windows for natural light and views. Room sharing options will also be available.

The design clusters rooms to create a sense of community. Each cluster has small dining and lounge areas, providing opportunities for families to meet for private leisure time.

Residential respite accommodation will also be available, so that older people can enjoy a short break.

The site is designed to cater for people with dementia and/or high level clinical care. Some areas will be dedicated to specialised care for people with dementia and associated behaviours.

Complementing the local community

Resthaven Aberfoyle Park is adjacent to the Aberfoyle Village Shopping Centre, with a large range of food and retail outlets, schools and leisure facilities. It is in easy reach of health services and medical centres.

The main bus route travels along Hub Drive, with a bus stop immediately outside Resthaven Aberfoyle Park.

The Onkaparinga Council provides community transport services with a connection to the public bus service at the Shopping Centre.

Resthaven Aberfoyle Park will support older people who require assistance with daily living, and who have been assessed as requiring residential aged care and / or respite accommodation.


